Learning objective: To identify and understand key terms used when creating landscape art.

Read the front of the card to Zara the Zebra. Try to guess the answer before looking at the back. Use the word bank if you get stuck!

What is a piece of art that shows the outdoors, like hills, trees, or the sea?	What is the line where the earth meets the sky?
Landscape	Horizon
Which part of the picture is closest to you and looks the largest?	Which part of the picture is furthest away, near the horizon?
Foreground	Background
What do we call the way we arrange things on our paper?	What is a quick, light drawing used to plan an idea?
Composition	Sketch
What do you call the feel or look of a surface, like rough bark or soft grass?	What is the book where an artist keeps their drawings and ideas?
Texture	Sketchbook
What do we call colours that are opposite each other on the colour wheel, like blue and orange?	What word describes colours that are calm and cool, like blue, green, and purple?
Complementary colours	Cool colours
What word describes colours that are bright and warm, like red, yellow, and orange?	What is the main subject or the most important part of your painting?
Warm colours	Focal point
