

Zara's Colourful Landscape Adventure

Learning objective: To explore landscapes and identify natural features while using observational skills to describe colours and patterns in the environment.

Zara the zebra is an artist who sees patterns everywhere! Look at the landscape scenes below. For each scene, choose a word from the word bank to describe the main feature you see. Then, write one colour you might use to paint that part of the picture.

Word bank: Mountain · River · Forest · Meadow · Beach

1. 1. Zara sees a tall, pointy shape reaching towards the clouds. What is it? Colour: (2 marks)

2. 2. Zara sees long, blue water flowing through the grass. What is it? Colour: (2 marks)

3. 3. Zara sees many tall trees standing close together. What is it? Colour: (2 marks)

4. 4. Zara sees soft sand and the edge of the sea. What is it? Colour: (2 marks)

5. 5. Zara sees a field full of tall, waving grass and flowers. What is it? Colour: (2 marks)

Draw: Imagine you are standing on a big hill with Zara. Draw the landscape you see in front of you. Remember to include at least three different things from our word bank, like a river winding past some forest trees!



Extension challenge: Go for a walk in your local park or garden. How many different patterns can you spot? Draw a picture of the most interesting pattern you find, just like Zara would!
