- A landscape is a picture that shows the land, such as hills, trees, or rivers.
- The things closest to us in a painting are in the foreground and look bigger.
- The things furthest away from us are in the background and look smaller.
- You can use bright colours to show a sunny day or cool colours for a snowy mountain.
- Artists look at shapes and patterns in nature to help them draw the countryside.

Did you know? Did you know? Artists often use a line called the 'horizon' to show where the land meets the sky! You can find this line in almost every landscape painting.
