1. Where did you find your pattern? (For example: on a rug, on a leaf, or on some fabric) (2 marks)

2. Describe the colours and shapes you see. Do they repeat in a special way? (3 marks)

3. Is the pattern symmetrical? (Does it look the same if you fold it in half?) (2 marks)

4. How does the pattern make you feel? (For example: happy, calm, or excited) (1 mark)
