

Zara the Zebra's Pattern Party

Learning objective: To identify, describe, and create patterns using colours and shapes.

Look at Zara the Zebra! She loves patterns. Can you colour in the stripes on her coat and the geometric shapes around her using your favourite colours? Try to make a repeating pattern!

Colour this: A large, friendly cartoon zebra named Zara standing in the centre. Zara has clear, thick black-and-white stripes on her body that are blank for the child to colour. Surrounding Zara are various simple geometric shapes like circles, triangles, and squares floating in the air. The background is simple and clean, featuring a few tufts of grass and some large, simple flowers with dotted centres to encourage pattern-based colouring.



Steps:

1. Label the stripe on Zara's back.
2. Label a circle shape in the background.
