- A pattern is when shapes or colours repeat in a special order.
- You can make a pattern using two different colours, like red and blue.
- Look for patterns on Zara the Zebra; she has black and white stripes that go over and over again.
- Patterns can be found in our classroom, like the squares on a tiled floor or the dots on a dice.
- When you draw a pattern, try to keep the same order to make it look tidy and clever.
