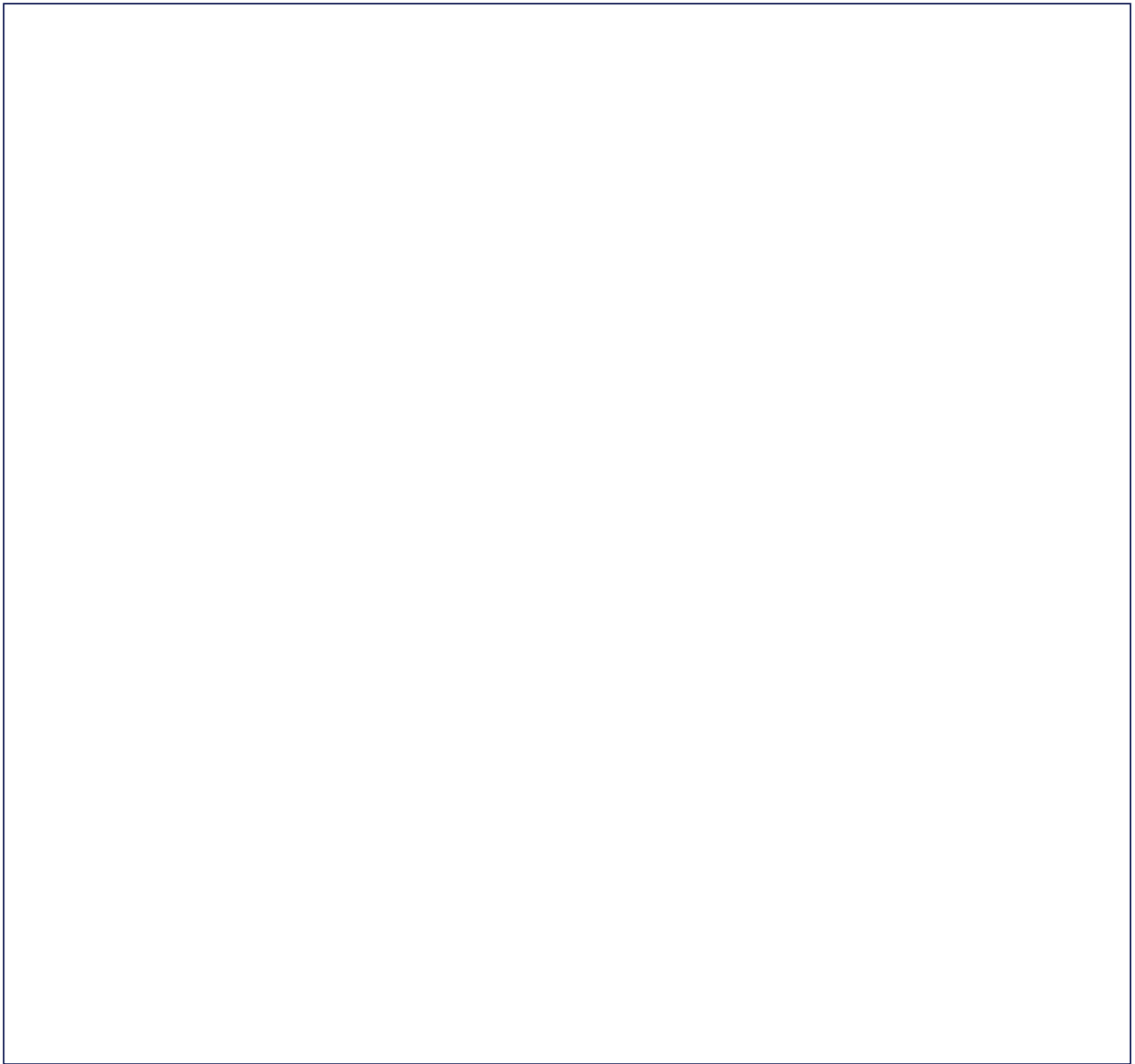


Zara's Sketching Adventure

Learning objective: To develop fine motor skills and explore the art technique of sketching using lines and patterns.

Look at the picture of Zara the zebra sketching in the park. Use your pencils to trace the lines in her sketchbook. Then, add your own patterns to the grass and the sky. Use different colours to make your drawing bright and cheerful!

Colour this: A large, friendly zebra named Zara sitting on a grassy patch in a park. Zara is holding a small wooden pencil in her hoof and looking down at an open sketchbook resting on her lap.
