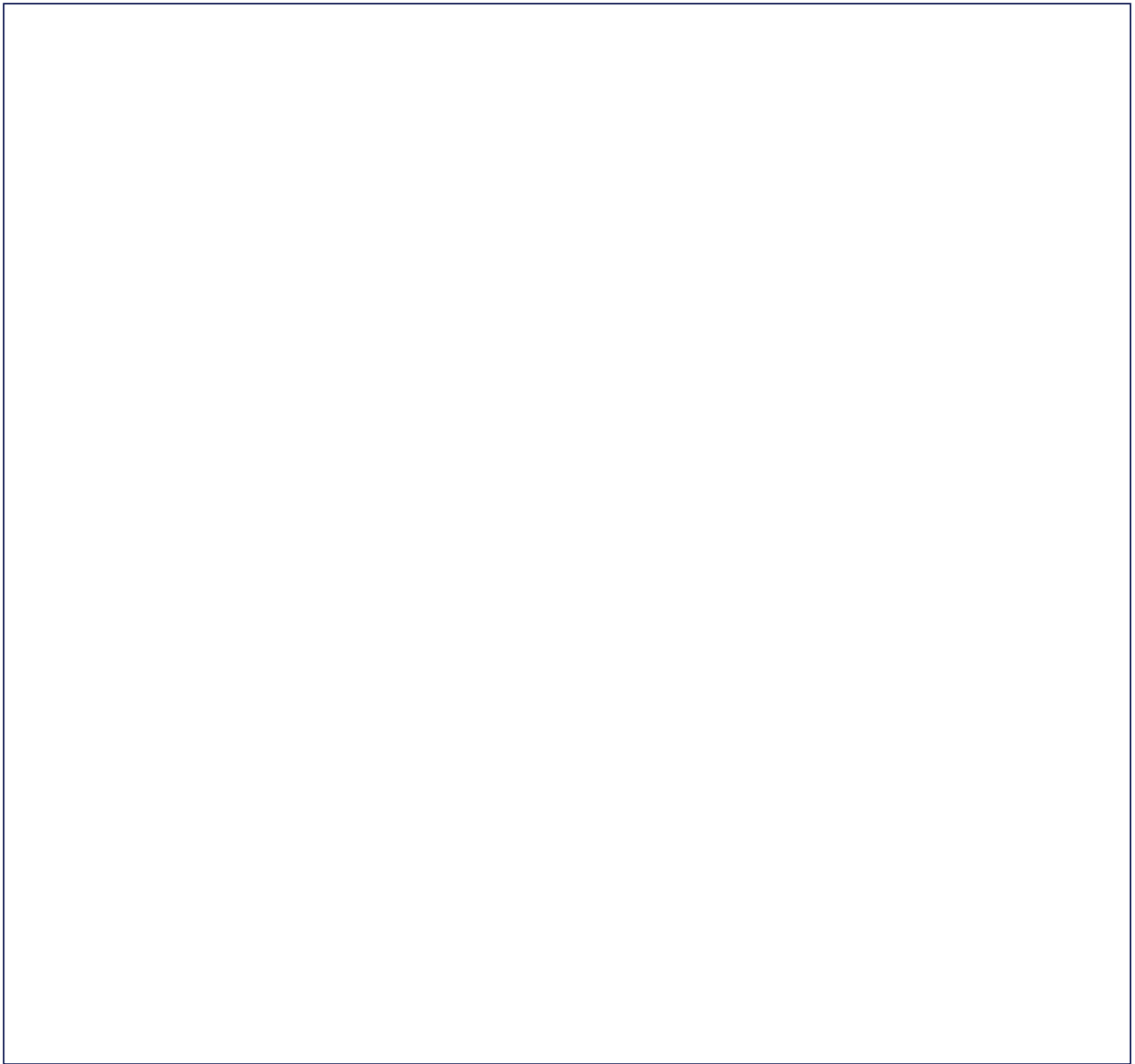


Zara's Fruit Bowl Still Life

Learning objective: To develop fine motor skills and observational drawing techniques by exploring the concept of still life through colouring and labelling.

Look at the still life arrangement Zara the Zebra has set up. Use your brightest crayons or pencils to colour the fruit and the bowl. Think about the shapes you see—are they circles, ovals, or curves? Once you have finished colouring, use your best handwriting to label the parts of the picture.

Colour this: A clean, simple line-art illustration of a table with a large, round fruit bowl in the centre. Inside the bowl, draw three large apples with small stems and two bananas curved like smiles. To the side of the bowl, draw a single pear. Include Zara the Zebra standing next to the table, smiling, with a paintbrush in her hand. Ensure the lines are thick and bold for easy colouring. The background should be plain to keep the focus on the still life arrangement.



Steps:

1. Label the round fruit in the bowl.

2. Label the container holding the fruit.
