

Zara the Zebra's Starry Night

Learning objective: To explore the artistic style of Vincent van Gogh by observing swirls, thick lines, and bright colours.

Look at the patterns in the picture. Use bright yellows for the stars and deep blues for the night sky. Try to make your lines swirly, just like Vincent van Gogh did!
