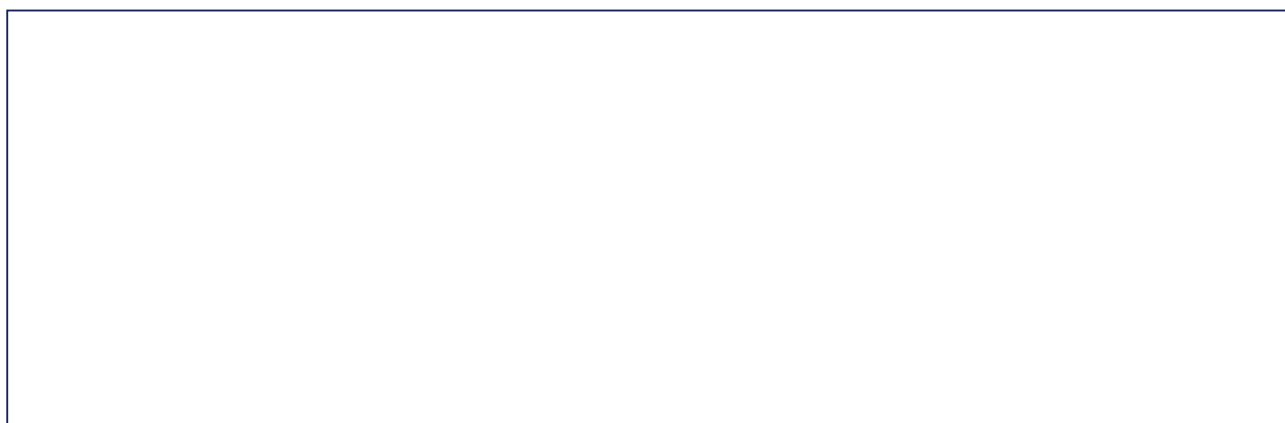
3. Max jumps on a branch. (How does he jump?)
