

Max's Maths Adventure: Adverbs

Learning objective: To identify and use adverbs to describe how an action happens.

Read the story below. Find the words that tell us how Max does his actions. These are called adverbs. Look at the word bank to help you. Use the sentence starters to help you write your answers.

Max the monkey loves to solve maths puzzles. Today, he found a big puzzle under a tree. Max counted the numbers carefully. He wrote the answer down quickly. When he finished, he cheered happily. Max is very proud of his work.
