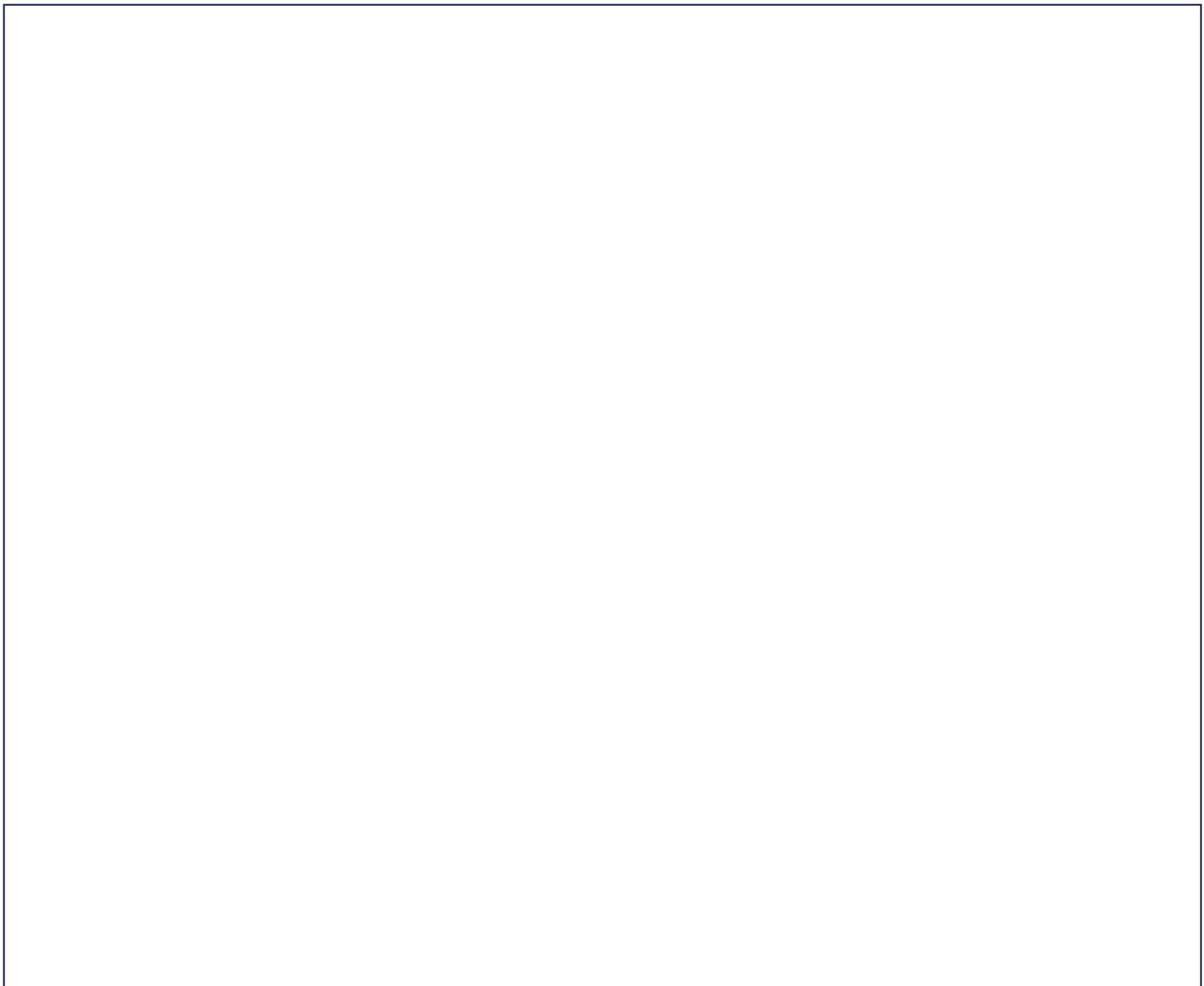


Celebrating Heroes: Black History Month

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate the contributions of important figures in Black history by creating a commemorative poster.

Follow the steps below to draw your tribute poster. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing. Think about a person who has made the world a better place.

Draw: Create a portrait poster in a clean, bold style. Place your chosen person in the middle. Use bright colours for the background. Surround the person with small symbols of their success. Leave space at the bottom for your descriptive sentence.



Label words: Hero · Kindness · Courage · Change · Inspiration · Achievement

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a portrait of a hero in the centre of your page. Who did you choose?
2. Step 2: Draw three items around them that represent what they achieved (e.g., a book for an author, a medal for a sports star). List your items here:
3. Step 3: Label your drawing using at least two words from the word bank.
4. Step 4: Write one sentence at the bottom explaining why this person is an inspiration.
