Learning objective: To identify and explain the features of a book review and share an opinion.

Read the story below. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions. Write your answers in the boxes.

Max the monkey sat in the library. He had just finished reading a book about a space-travelling squirrel. Max wanted to tell his friends what he thought about it, so he wrote a review.

'The book is called The Starry Acorn,' Max wrote. 'It is a brilliant story about a squirrel who builds a rocket ship out of old logs. 5. Would you like to read this book? Explain why using your own opinion. (Evaluative) (2 marks)
