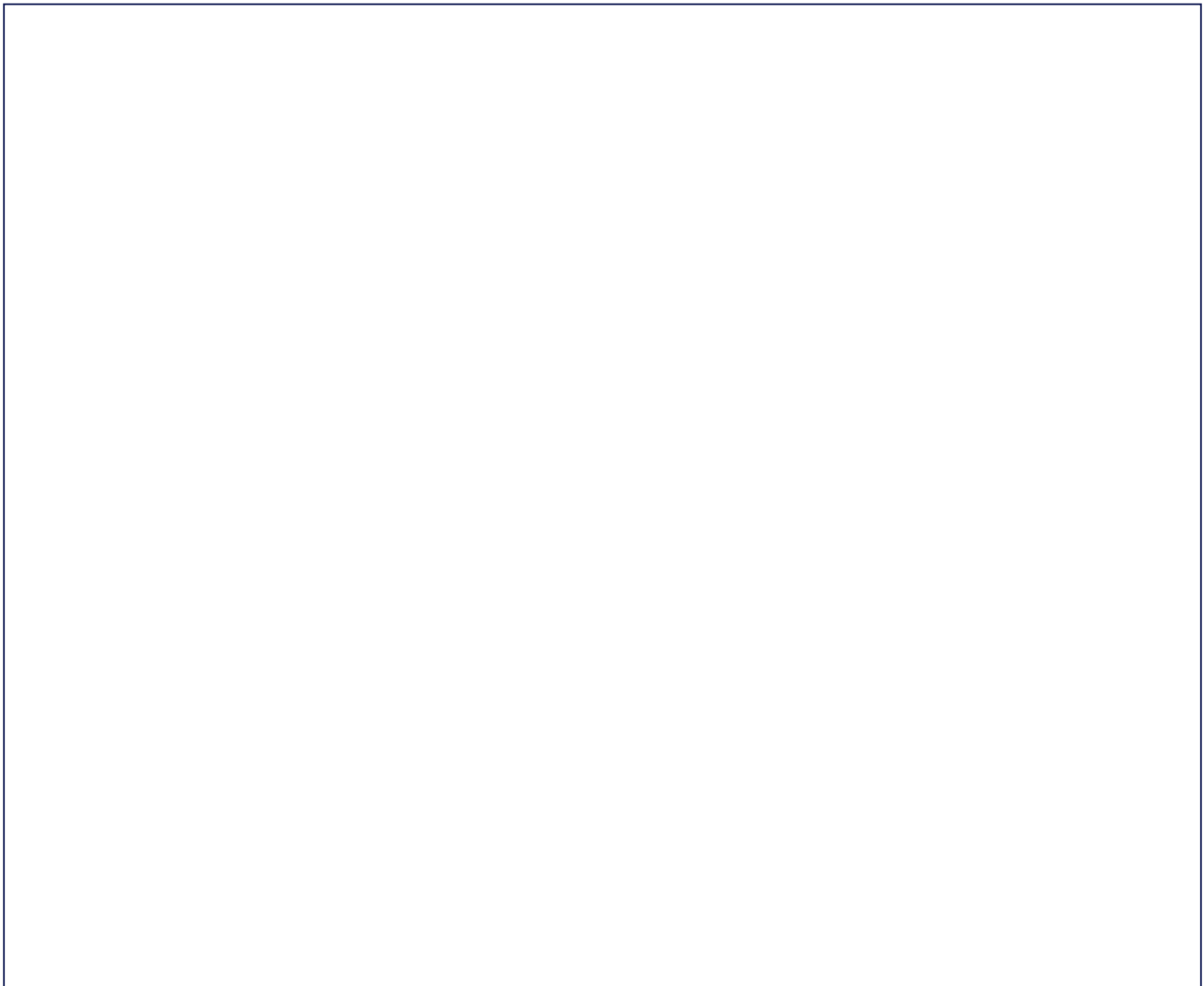


My Favourite Book Scene: A Review with Pip

Learning objective: To create a visual representation of a story setting and identify key elements of a book review.

Follow the steps below to draw your favourite scene from a book you have enjoyed. Use the word bank to help you add labels to your drawing.

Draw: Draw a large rectangular scene that shows a story setting. Use bright colours to show if the mood is happy, exciting, or calm. Include a character from your favourite book. Make sure the character is doing something important to the story. Label the parts of your drawing with arrows pointing to the setting, the character, and one important object from the scene.



Label words: Setting · Character · Action · Mood · Important Object

Steps:

1. Step 1: In the space provided, draw the place where your story happens (the setting). What do you see there?
2. Step 2: Draw the main character in the middle of an action. What are they doing?
3. Step 3: Label your drawing using at least three words from the word bank.
4. Step 4: Write one sentence to explain why this scene is your favourite part of the book.
