

My Book Review with Pip the Caterpillar

Learning objective: To write a short review sharing my opinion on a book I have read.

Read the short story below. Then, use the sentence starters to help you write your review. Pip the bookworm loves to hear what you think!

In the story 'The Lost Key', a small squirrel named Nutty finds a shiny, silver key under a big oak tree. Nutty goes on a journey through the forest to find which door the key opens. Along the way, Nutty meets a friendly rabbit who helps him look. Finally, they find a tiny wooden box hidden in a hollow log. Inside the box, they find a collection of yummy acorns to share with all their forest friends.

1. Who is the main character in the story? (1 mark)

2. What is one thing that happened in the story? Use the sentence starter: First, the squirrel... (2 marks)

3. Did you like this story? Why? Use the sentence starter: I liked the story because... (2 marks)

4. Would you tell a friend to read this book? Use the sentence starter: I would/would not recommend this book because... (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of the silver key or the wooden box that Nutty the squirrel found in the forest.



Extension challenge: Write one new sentence about what you think was inside the box if it were a magical surprise!
