

A Snowy Surprise with Leo the Lion

Learning objective: To use descriptive language to write about a winter scene.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you write your sentences. Remember to use capital letters and full stops.

Leo the Lion is writing a poem about his favourite snowy Christmas morning in the forest. He sees the trees covered in white snow. Everything looks quiet and beautiful.

Word bank: sparkling · festive · cheerful · snowy · golden · bright · shimmering · winter

1. Leo looks at the trees. Use an adjective from the word bank to describe the snowy trees. (2 marks)

2. Leo feels very happy. Write a sentence about how Leo feels on this festive day. (2 marks)

3. Imagine a gift for Leo. If the gift costs £5.50, write the price in words. (1 mark)

4. Complete this sentence: The snow looks _____ under the moon. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of Leo the Lion standing in a snowy forest. Make sure to draw some sparkling snow on the ground!



Extension challenge: Can you write one more sentence to finish Leo's poem? Think about what sound the snow makes when you walk on it.
