

Easter Stories with Ellie the Elephant

Learning objective: To use descriptive language and visual representation to show understanding of traditional Easter symbols and themes.

Follow the steps below to create your Easter scene. Use your best handwriting for the labels.

Draw: Create a peaceful garden scene. Include Ellie the Elephant standing on soft green grass. In the background, draw a tree with small pink blossom flowers to show that spring has arrived. Style: Use bright, cheerful colours. Keep lines clean and clear. Add a sunny sky above the garden.



Label words: spring · blossom · new life · tradition · celebration · daffodil

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, bright yellow daffodil in the corner of your page. Label the flower.
2. Step 2: Draw Ellie the Elephant holding a basket of spring flowers. What are two other things in her basket?
3. Step 3: Draw a small bird sitting on a branch with new green leaves. Label the bird.
4. Step 4: Write one sentence at the bottom of your page to describe why spring is a time for new life.
