Learning objective: To identify and use nouns and verbs correctly in sentences.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank if you get stuck. Write your answers on the lines provided.

8. Write a short story about Pip the caterpillar. Use at least two nouns and two verbs. (5 marks) (5 marks)
