

Max's Maths and Word Fun

Learning objective: To identify nouns and verbs in sentences.

Max the monkey is sorting his word collection. A noun is a person, place, or thing. A verb is an action word. Read each sentence carefully. Follow the sentence starters to help you.

Word bank: Monkey · Jump · Book · Run · Tree · Eat · Park · Play

1. Max is a monkey. Circle the noun in this sentence: 'The monkey climbed the tall tree.' (2 marks)

2. Max loves to move! Underline the verb in this sentence: 'The monkey can jump very high.' (2 marks)

3. Look at this sentence: 'Pip reads a book.' Write the noun here: _____. Write the verb here: _____. (2 marks)

4. Write your own sentence using one noun and one verb from the word bank. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the monkey doing an action (a verb) in a place (a noun). Label the noun and the verb in your drawing.
