- A paragraph is a group of sentences that are all about the same topic.
- When you start a new idea, you must start a new paragraph.
- You can use an indent or an empty line to show where a new paragraph begins.
- Paragraphs help the reader understand your story or report much more easily.
- Always check that your sentences flow in an order that makes sense.

Did you know? Did you know? The word 'paragraph' comes from the Ancient Greek word 'paragraphos', which means 'to write beside'. It acts like a little fence around a group of sentences that share one big idea!
