

My Adventure Diary with Pip the Caterpillar

Learning objective: To learn how to group ideas into clear paragraphs using a diary entry format.

Today, we are writing a diary entry about a day out with Pip the bookworm caterpillar. Remember to use a new paragraph for each new idea. Use the boxes below to help you organise your writing. Start each paragraph with a capital letter and end with a full stop.

Word bank: paragraph · adventure · caterpillar · sunny · crawled · exciting · friend · yesterday · afterwards · finally

1. Paragraph 1: The Beginning. Write one sentence about where you went with Pip and what the weather was like. (2 marks)

2. Paragraph 2: The Middle. Write two sentences about what Pip found or what you did together during the day. (3 marks)

3. Paragraph 3: The End. Write one sentence about how you felt at the end of the day. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you add a fourth paragraph to your diary? Tell me one thing you would like to do with Pip next time!
