Learning objective: To use full stops, capital letters, and question marks correctly in sentences.

Read each sentence carefully. Add the missing punctuation marks where they are needed. Use a capital letter at the start of every sentence.

Word bank: Capital letter · Full stop · Question mark · Sentence · Punctuation

1. 1. max loves to eat bananas. (Fix the capital letter and add the missing punctuation.) (2 marks)

2. 2. can you help me count these coins. (This is a question. Fix the capital letter and add the correct punctuation mark.) (2 marks)

3. 3. the monkey found five pounds. (Fix the capital letter and add the missing punctuation.) (2 marks)

4. 4. is it time for lunch. (Fix the capital letter and add the correct punctuation mark.) (2 marks)

5. 5. Write your own sentence about Max the Monkey. Remember to start with a capital letter and end with a full stop. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the Monkey holding a basket with £5 in it.



Extension challenge: Can you write a sentence that uses an exclamation mark to show that Max is excited?
