Learning objective: To practise reading comprehension skills by identifying facts and inferring meaning from a short text.

Read the story about Max. Then, answer the questions below. Use the word bank if you need help with spelling.

Max the monkey went to the local market on Saturday. He had £5 in his pocket. He saw a stall full of shiny red apples. The apples cost £2 for a big bag. Max bought one bag. He felt very happy with his snack. He walked home to share the fruit with his friends.

9. 9. Did Max eat the apples all by himself? (Yes/No) (1 mark)

10. 10. Where did Max go after the market? (1 mark)
