1. Book Title and Author: Write the name of the book you read and who wrote it. (1 mark)

2. What is the story about? Use a sentence starter: 'This story is about...' (2 marks)

3. Who is your favourite character? Explain why. Use a sentence starter: 'My favourite character is... because...' (2 marks)

4. Did you enjoy the book? Tell me what you liked or disliked about it. (2 marks)
