

Max's Maths Report: Sorting the Facts

Learning objective: To identify and order the features of a non-chronological report.

Max the monkey is writing a report about his favourite jungle fruit. He has mixed up his sentences! Look at the sentences in the questions below. Decide if they are a 'Title', 'Introduction', 'Sub-heading', or 'Fact'. Write the correct label next to each sentence. Use the word bank to help you.

Word bank: Title · Introduction · Sub-heading · Fact

1. 1. 'The Amazing Mango' (This tells the reader what the report is about.) (2 marks)

2. 2. 'Mangoes are juicy fruits that grow on big trees in hot places.' (This tells us what a mango is.) (2 marks)

3. 3. 'Where do they grow?' (This tells us what the next section is about.) (2 marks)

4. 4. 'A mango can weigh up to 500 grams.' (This is a specific piece of information.) (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a juicy mango on a tree to go with Max's report.



Extension challenge: Can you write one more 'Fact' sentence about a different fruit, like a banana or an apple?
