

Story Building with Max the Monkey

Learning objective: To learn the parts of a story and use exciting adjectives to describe characters.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you write your answers. Max the Monkey needs your help to finish his story map!

Word bank: Setting · Character · Plot · Adjective · Problem · Solution · Exciting · Kind

1. Every story needs someone to act in it. What is the name for the person or animal in a story? (2 marks)

2. Max wants to describe a hero. Write two adjectives you could use to describe a brave hero. (2 marks)

3. A story needs a place where the action happens. What do we call this part of a story? (2 marks)

4. Every story needs a 'problem' for the hero to fix. Can you name one problem a character might have? (2 marks)

5. What do we call the way a character fixes their problem at the end of the story? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a hero character in their favourite setting. Label one item in your drawing using an adjective (for example: 'a shiny sword' or 'a tall tree').



Extension challenge: Choose one of your adjectives and write a full sentence about your character. For example: 'The kind monkey climbed the tall tree.'
