

# Pip's Word Collector: My Favourite Words

*Learning objective: To identify and use interesting vocabulary to describe feelings, objects, and actions.*

Pip the caterpillar loves collecting new words! Use this sheet to find exciting words to replace 'boring' ones. Read the prompts and write your own descriptive sentences.

*Word bank: enormous · tiny · shimmering · dull · joyful · gloomy · sprinted · trudged · magnificent · baffling*

**1. Pip has found a boring word: 'big'. Write a new, exciting word to describe something large, and write a sentence using it. (2 marks)**

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**2. Think of a word to describe how you feel when you learn something new. Write your word and tell me why you chose it. (2 marks)**

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**3. Max the monkey is moving quickly. Instead of 'ran', what exciting action word could you use? Write it in a sentence. (2 marks)**

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**4. Find a word from the word bank that describes something bright and shiny. Write a sentence about a 'shimmering' object. (2 marks)**
