

World Book Day Fun with Pip the Caterpillar

Learning objective: To use adjectives and descriptive language to talk about our favourite books.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank if you need help with spelling. Remember to use capital letters and full stops.

Word bank: exciting · favourite · character · adjective · story · adventure · magical · funny

1. Pip the caterpillar loves to read. What is the title of your favourite book? (1 mark)

2. Think of one character from your book. Write a sentence to describe them. (Use an adjective like 'brave' or 'kind'). (2 marks)

3. Why do you like this book? Start your sentence with: I like this book because... (2 marks)

4. If you could visit the setting of the story, what would you see? Write two things. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw your favourite character from a book standing next to Pip the caterpillar. Make sure they are reading a book together!



Extension challenge: Write a short sentence about what you would wear if you dressed up as your favourite character for World Book Day.
