Learning objective: To identify, describe, and understand key geographical features and countries within the continent of Asia.

Join Finn the dolphin on his global mapping adventure! Use your geography textbook, an atlas, or a digital map to research Asia. Complete each section of this fact-file to show what you have learned about this diverse continent. Be sure to use your best handwriting and check your spelling of place names.

1. Location and Borders: Where is Asia located on a world map? Which oceans and continents border it? (3 marks)

2. Climate Zones: Asia is huge! Describe two different climate zones found in Asia (e.g., tropical, polar, or arid) and where they are located. (4 marks)

3. Famous Physical Features: Choose one mountain range and one major river in Asia. Explain why these are important features. (4 marks)

4. Human Geography: List three major cities in Asia and describe one interesting fact about the human geography (culture, transport, or landmarks) of one of them. (3 marks)

5. Economic Connections: If you were trading goods between the UK and an Asian country, what might you import or export? Mention an example using £ to show the cost of a item. (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Research a specific Asian country and draw its flag. Write three bullet points underneath explaining how the symbols or colours on the flag represent the country's history or values.
