

Finn's Earth Shakers Activity

Learning objective: To understand that an earthquake is a natural event where the ground shakes and to identify how to stay safe.

Finn the dolphin has been exploring the world's geography and wants to help you learn about earthquakes. Look at the sentences below. Decide if each one is 'True' or 'False'. If you think a sentence is false, write one sentence explaining why it is not correct.
