

Finn's Geography Sort: Natural vs. Built

Learning objective: To identify and sort features of the environment into physical (natural) and human (built) categories.

Finn the dolphin is exploring our world! Look at the list of things below. Decide if each one is a Physical feature (made by nature) or a Human feature (built by people). Write the name of the feature in the correct box in the table.

1. Draw a table with two columns: 'Physical Features' and 'Human Features'. Sort these words into the correct column: Mountain, Bridge, River, Shop, Forest, Road, Beach, Castle. (4 marks)

2. Which feature is a Physical feature? Choose one from your list and explain why it is natural. (2 marks)

3. Which feature is a Human feature? Choose one from your list and explain why it was built by people. (2 marks)

4. Finn sees a large stone bridge over a river. Is the bridge a Physical or Human feature? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of a park. Include at least two Physical features (like trees or a pond) and two Human features (like a bench or a path). Label your features.



Extension challenge: Think of one more Human feature in your own town or village. Why did people decide to build it there?
