Benin City

What famous metalwork were the craftsmen of Benin famous for creating?

Bronze (and brass) plaques and sculptures

What was the name of the language spoken by the people of the Benin Kingdom?

Edo

What were some of the key goods traded by the Benin Kingdom with European explorers?

Pepper, ivory, and cloth

What were the bronze plaques used for in the Oba's palace?

To record history and decorate the walls of the palace

What were the 'Guilds' in Benin society?

Groups of specialist craftsmen, such as bronze-casters or ivory-carvers, who worked for the Oba

How did the Benin Kingdom protect its capital city?

By building massive earthworks and a deep moat around the city
