

Social Studies / History Heroes: Mary Seacole's Journey

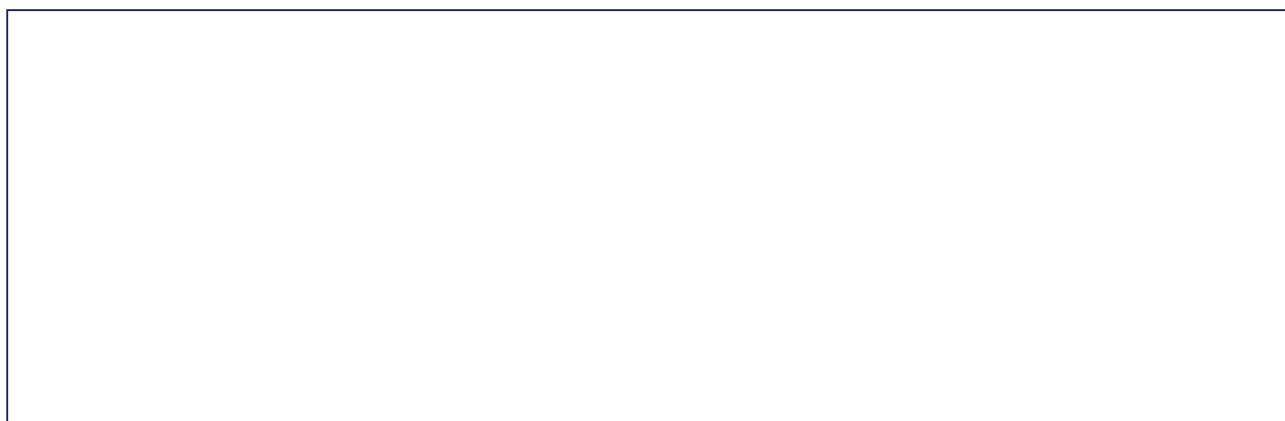
Learning objective: To learn about the life and significant contributions of Mary Seacole, a significant historical figure who helped others.
