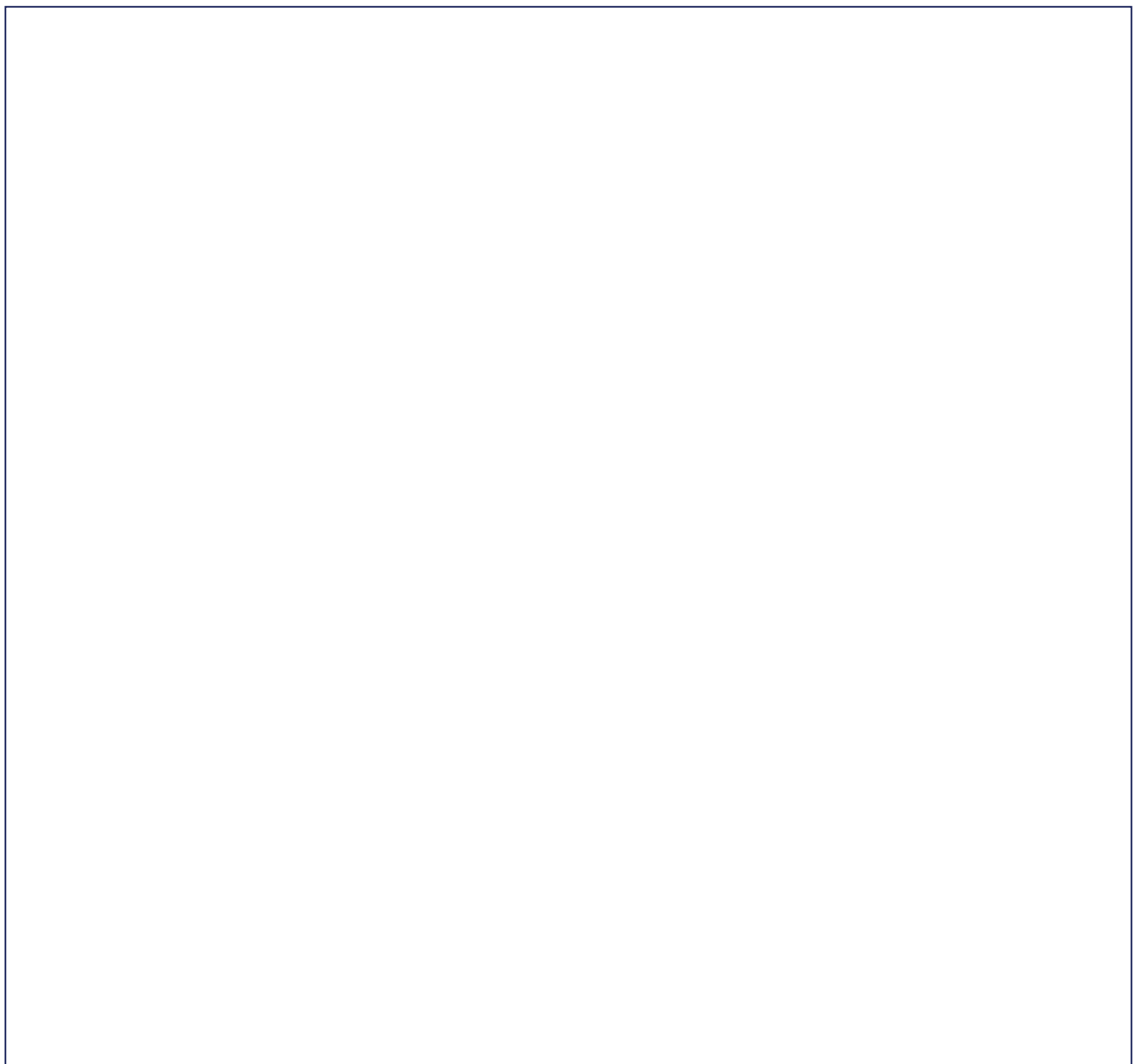


Social Studies / History Heroes: Learning about Mary Seacole

Learning objective: To recognise and learn about the significant historical contribution of Mary Seacole.

Read the facts about Mary Seacole, colour in the picture, and label the items she used to help people.
