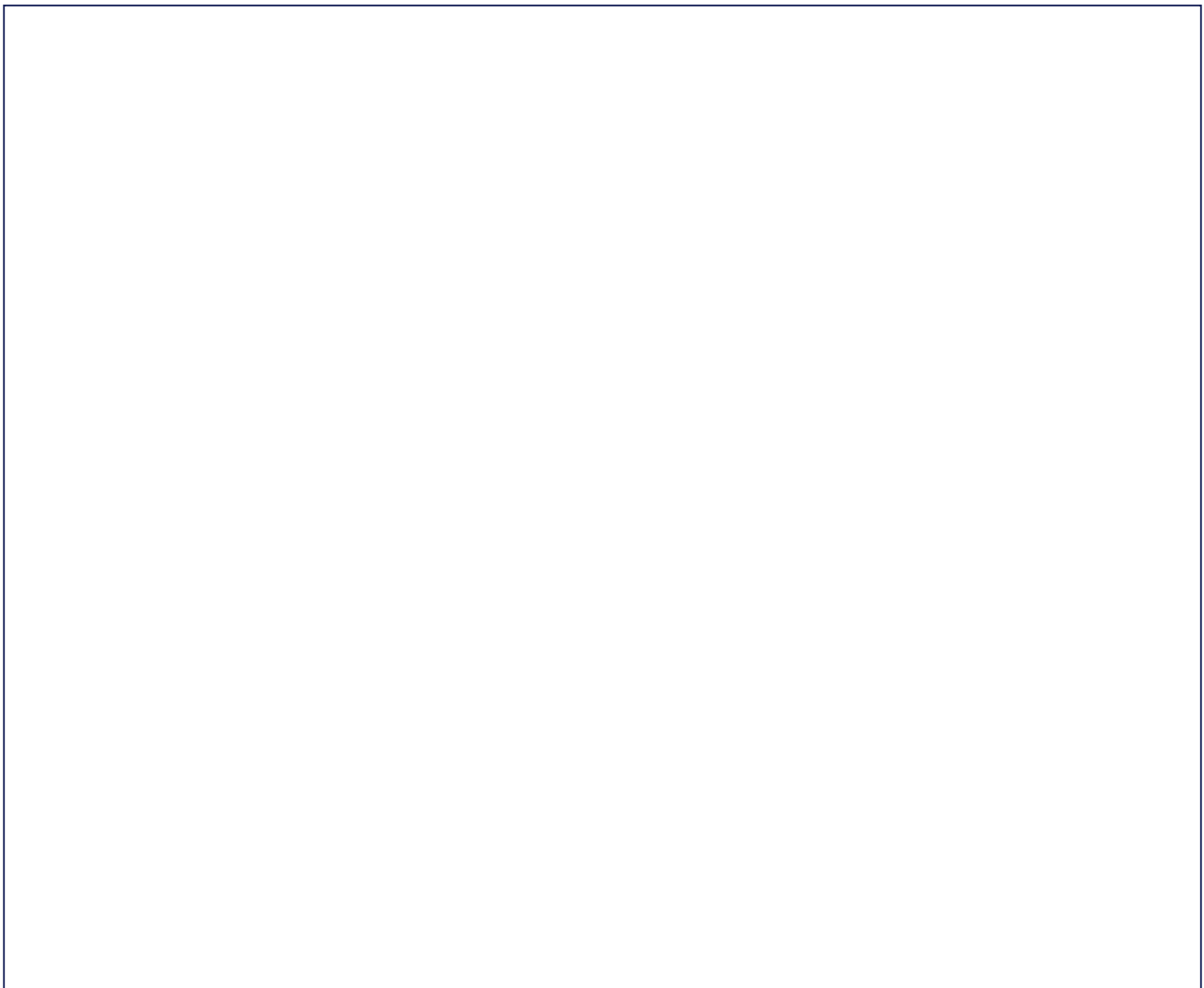


Social Studies / History Heroes: Mary Seacole

Learning objective: To learn about the life and contributions of Mary Seacole, a significant historical figure who cared for others.

Today, we are learning about Mary Seacole. She was a brave nurse who travelled a long way to help soldiers during the Crimean War. Use the space below to draw a picture showing how Mary helped people, then answer the questions to show what you have learnt.

Draw: Draw a picture of Mary Seacole in the centre of the page. Draw her wearing her nurse's uniform. Around her, draw the 'British Hotel' and some soldiers looking happy because she is helping them. Use bright colours to show that she is a hero. You may add Ellie the elephant in the corner, holding a history book about Mary!
