Word bank: Mary Seacole · Walter Tull · Rosa Parks · Nurse · Footballer · Bus

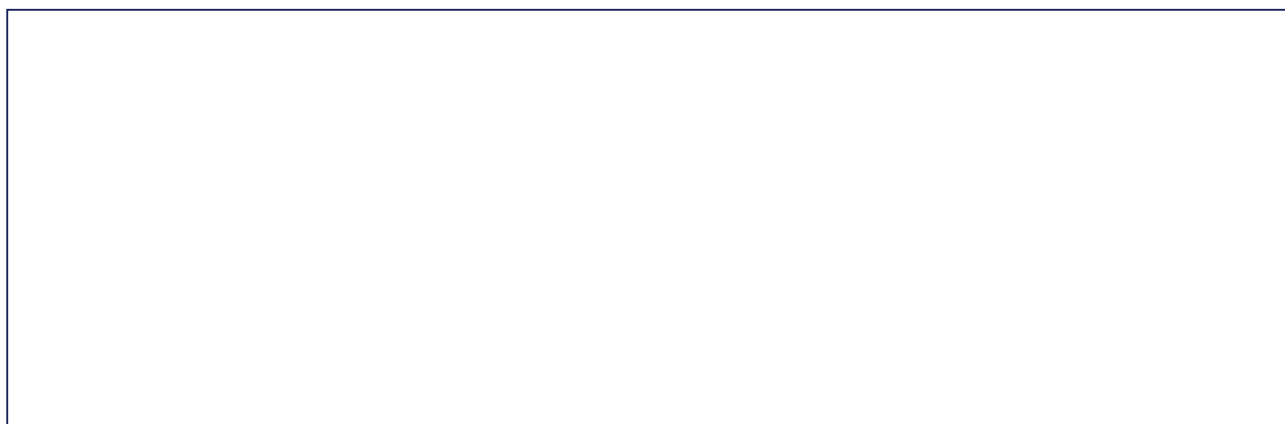
1. 1. Who was a brave nurse who helped soldiers during the Crimean War? (Write the name below) (1 mark)
