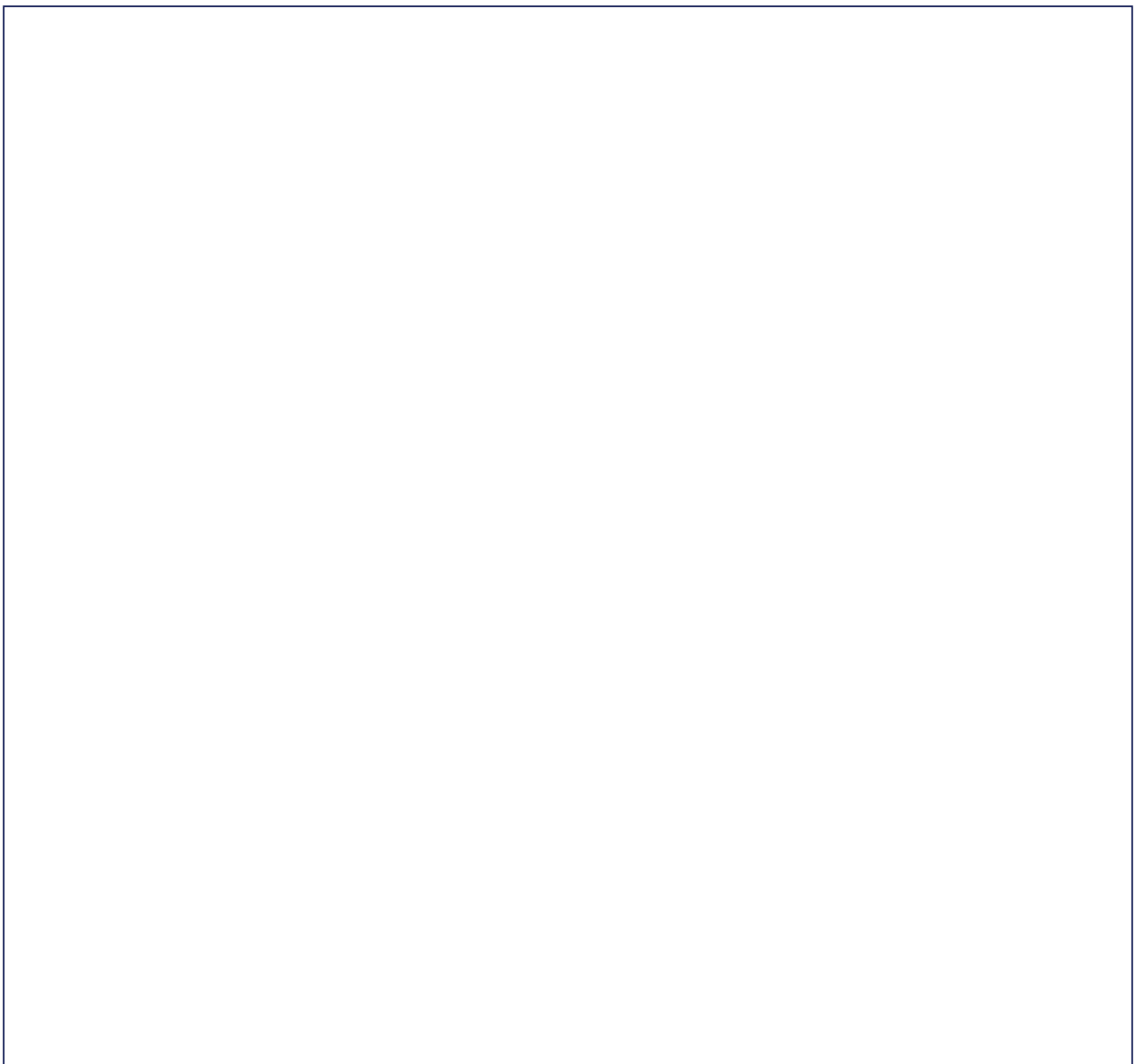


Celebrating Remarkable People

Learning objective: To recognise that Black history is part of our shared history and to learn about significant individuals who have shaped our world.

Colour in the picture of Ellie the elephant visiting a history museum. Read the facts about Mary Seacole and Rosa Parks, then complete the labelling tasks.

Colour this: A warm and inviting scene inside a museum. In the centre, Ellie the elephant is wearing a small spectacles-chain and holding a large magnifying glass over an open history book. On the museum wall behind her, there is a large, framed portrait of a smiling person. Next to the portrait, there is a small plaque. The floor has a simple patterned rug. The outlines should be thick and clear for colouring, with plenty of space for children to add their own colours to Ellie's clothing, the picture frame, and the museum walls.



Steps:

1. Label the portrait of the historical figure on the museum wall.
2. Label the magnifying glass that Ellie is using to look at the history book.
