

Social Studies / History Heroes: Mary Seacole

Learning objective: To recognise the contribution of Mary Seacole to history and identify her role as a nurse during the Crimean War.

Use the word bank to label your drawing. Add details to show how Mary Seacole helped people who were unwell.

Draw: Draw a large picture of Mary Seacole in the centre of the page. She should be wearing a kind expression and her nurse's uniform. In the background, draw a simple building representing the 'British Hotel' and some soft clouds. You can use bright colours to show that she was a helpful and caring person.



Label words: nurse · medicine · hospital · caring · brave · uniform
