

Ellie's Bronze Age Explorer Sheet

Learning objective: To understand and identify key features of life in Britain during the Bronze Age.

Help Ellie the elephant learn about the Bronze Age! Follow the steps below to complete your drawing. You can use your labels from the word bank to describe what you have drawn.

Draw: Draw a sunny Bronze Age scene. In the centre, draw a circular house with a thick straw roof (a roundhouse). Outside, draw a simple tool made of bronze. In the background, draw some tall standing stones arranged in a circle. Keep your lines clear and bold.



Label words: roundhouse · bronze axe · thatch roof · stone circle · field

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large roundhouse in the middle of your page. What material is on the roof? Add a label.
2. Step 2: Draw a bronze axe on the ground near the house. Why was bronze important? Write one sentence.
3. Step 3: Draw a stone circle in the distance. Label the stones.
4. Step 4: Draw a small field next to the house. What might a Bronze Age farmer grow? Add a label.
