Learning objective: To identify and describe key features of life in the British Bronze Age.

Read the front of the card to see the question. Flip it over (or check the back) to see the answer. Use the word bank to help you understand the terms.

What is the Bronze Age?	What two metals are mixed to make bronze?
A time in history when people started using bronze to make tools and weapons.	Copper and tin.
What is a roundhouse?	Did Bronze Age people hunt or farm?
A round house with a thatched roof where Bronze Age people lived.	They were farmers who grew crops and kept animals.
What did they use bronze to make?	How did they get metal from other places?
Tools like axes, weapons like swords, and jewellery.	By trading things like wool or salt with other groups.
What is a barrow?	What was the main material used before bronze?
A mound of earth built over a grave.	Stone.
What kind of clothing did they wear?	Where did they keep their animals at night?
Clothes made from wool or animal skins.	In fenced areas called enclosures to keep them safe.
