Learning objective: To identify and describe the actions of key figures who campaigned for civil rights and equality.

1. Name of the person: Write the name of the person you are learning about. (1 mark)

2. What was the problem?: Explain what was unfair. Why did they want to change things? (Sentence starter: They wanted to change...) (2 marks)

3. What did they do?: Describe the brave things they did to help others. (Sentence starter: They showed courage by...) (2 marks)

4. Why are they important?: Tell me why we remember them today. (Sentence starter: We remember them because...) (2 marks)
