

People Who Changed the World: A Writing Frame

Learning objective: To write a short recount about someone who worked for fairness and civil rights.

Use this frame to help you write about a person who fought for equality. Think about what they did and why they are important. Use the word bank to help you write your sentences.

Ellie the Elephant is learning about brave people who stood up for what was right, and now you can write about one too.

1. Who is the person you have chosen, and why were they a brave leader? Start your sentence with: I have chosen to write about... (2 marks)

2. What unfair rule or problem were they trying to change? Start your sentence with: The problem they wanted to fix was... (2 marks)

3. What did they do to help make the world more equal? Start your sentence with: To make things better, they decided to... (2 marks)

4. Why do we remember them today? Start your sentence with: We remember them today because... (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you add one extra sentence using the word 'justice' to explain how their actions helped other people?
