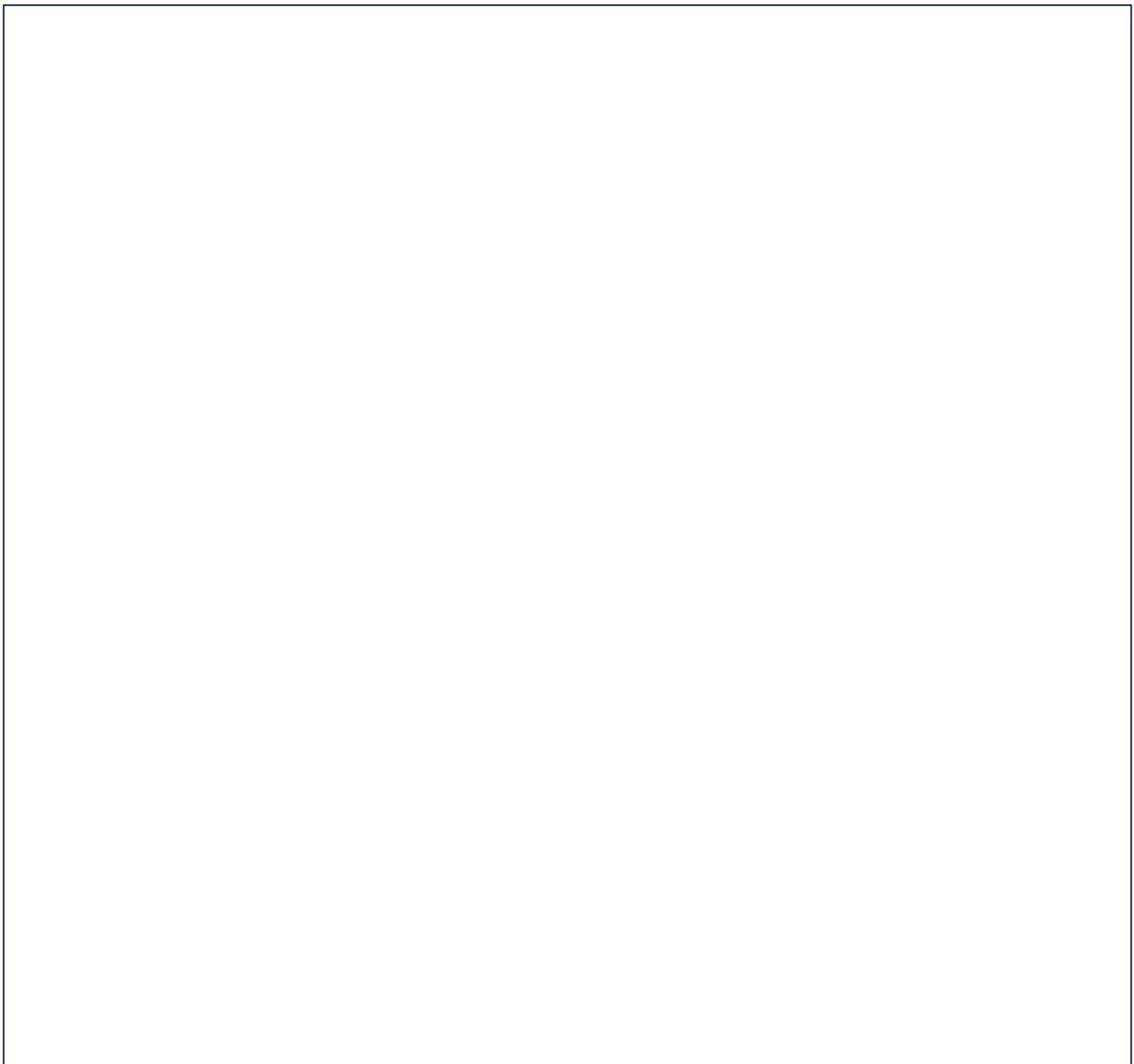


The Great Fire of London

Learning objective: To understand the events of the Great Fire of London in 1666.

Read the facts about the Great Fire of London below, then colour in the scene showing London in 1666. Finally, complete the labelling activity to show what you have learnt.

Colour this: A line-art scene of 17th-century London. In the foreground, there is a wide, curving river (the Thames) with a small wooden boat on it.
