2. Daily Life and Food: What was a staple crop for the Maya, and how did they obtain their food? (2 marks)

3. Writing and Communication: Explain how the Maya recorded information and what their writing system was called. (3 marks)

4. Scientific Achievements: Choose one area where the Maya were advanced (such as astronomy or maths) and explain their contribution. (3 marks)

5. Architecture: Describe the purpose of the large stone structures built in Maya cities. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you are a Maya architect. On the back of this sheet, design a building for a new city-state. Label the materials you would use and explain one special feature of your design.
