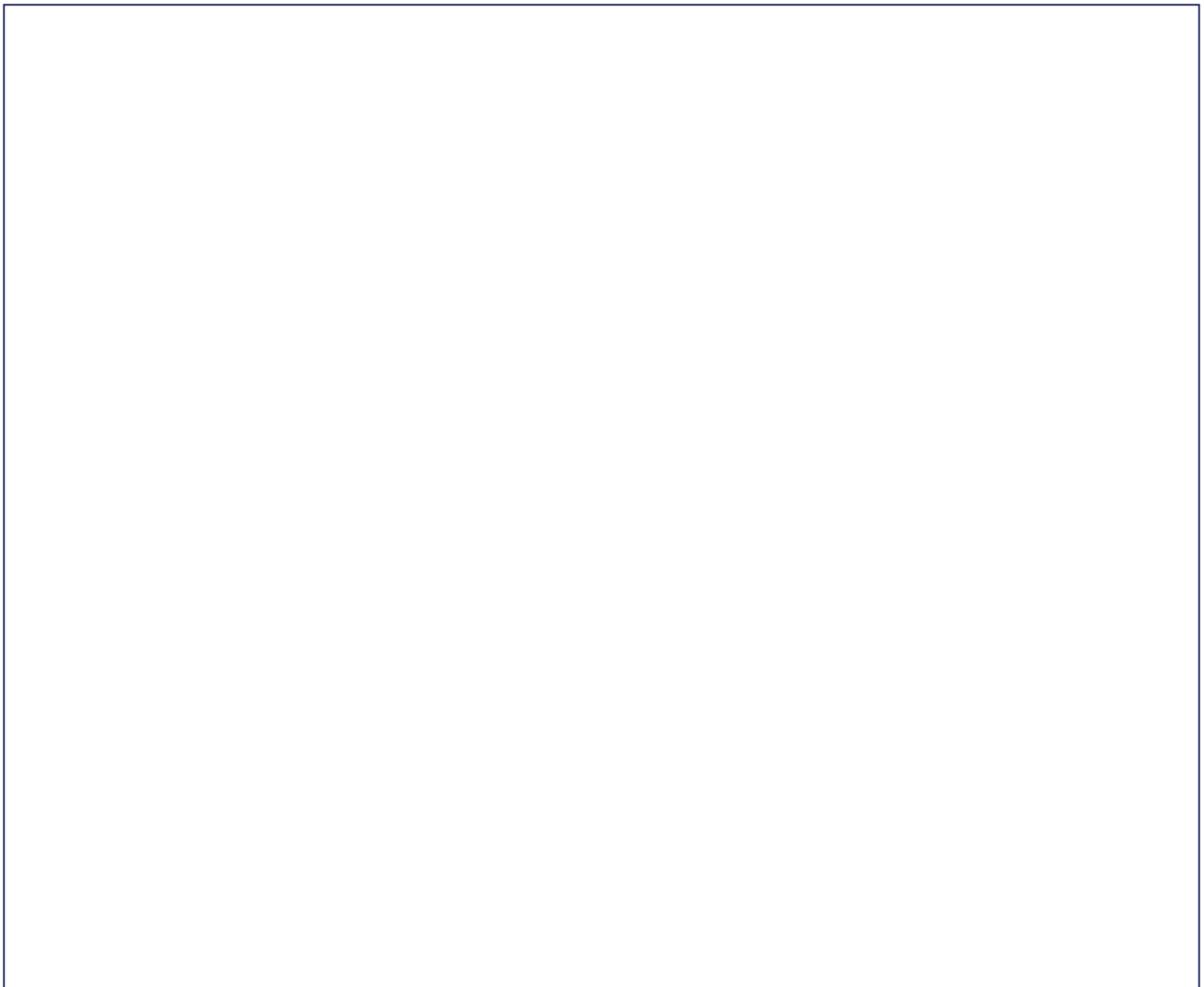


Remembrance Day Drawing Activity

Learning objective: To understand the symbols of Remembrance Day and reflect on why we show respect to those who served in wars.

Follow the steps below to create your Remembrance Day picture. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing. You can use felt tips, colouring pencils, or crayons.

Draw: Draw a large, bright red poppy in the centre of the page. Add a thin green stem and a small leaf. In the background, draw a soft green field. Use bold colours to show respect. You may draw a small sun in the corner to show peace.



Label words: Poppy · Petals · Stem · Leaf · Field · Respect · Memory

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large poppy in the middle of your page. What colour is a poppy?
2. Step 2: Draw a green stem and one leaf on your poppy. What does the poppy remind us to do?
3. Step 3: Label your drawing using three words from the word bank.
4. Step 4: Write one sentence about why we use the poppy as a symbol.
