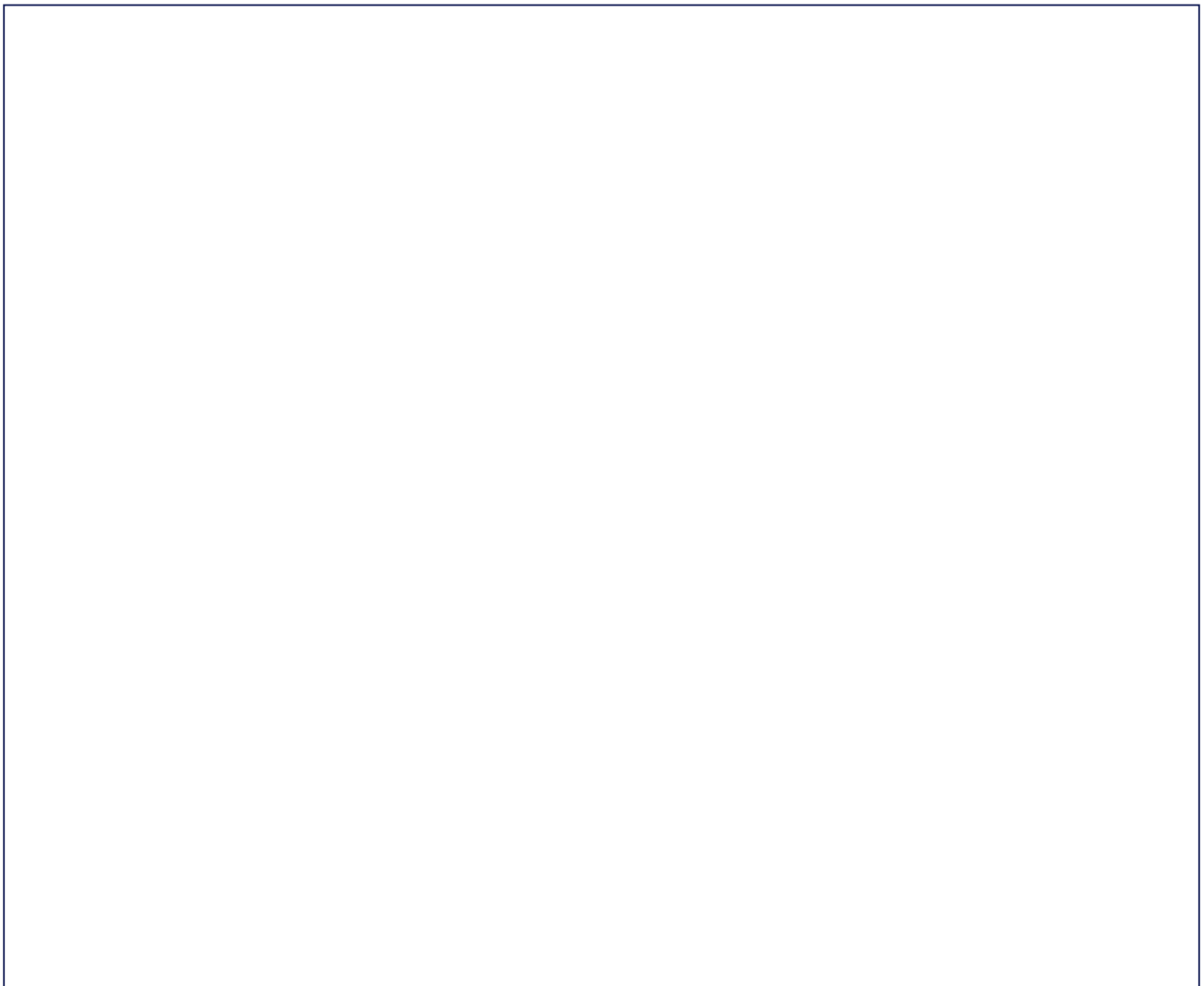


Ellie's Stone Age Discovery

Learning objective: To identify and draw key features of life in the Stone Age.

Follow the steps below to create your own Stone Age scene. Use the labels from the word bank to help you describe your drawing.

Draw: Create a scene of a Stone Age camp. Include a rocky cave entrance, a small fire with orange and yellow flames, a person wearing fur-like clothing, and simple tools made of stone scattered on the ground. Use earthy colours like brown, grey, and ochre to match the Stone Age theme.



Label words: Cave · Fire · Stone tools · Animal skin · Hunter-gatherers

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large cave in the background for shelter. Label your cave.
2. Step 2: Draw a bright fire in the front of your picture. Why was fire important? (Hint: Think about warmth or cooking).
3. Step 3: Draw a person wearing warm clothes made from animal skin. Label the clothes.
4. Step 4: Draw a sharp stone tool on the ground. Label the tool.
