- The Stone Age is split into three parts: the Palaeolithic, Mesolithic, and Neolithic periods.
- Early humans were hunter-gatherers who travelled to find food like berries, nuts, and wild animals.
- People used fire to keep warm, cook their food, and stay safe from wild animals at night.
- Stone Age tools were made by chipping hard rocks like flint into sharp edges for cutting.
- By the Neolithic period, people began to farm the land and build permanent homes in villages.

Did you know? Did you know? Stone Age people did not have shops! They made their own tools from sharp stone called flint and used animal skins to make warm clothes for the cold weather.
