

Ellie's Social Studies / History Lesson: The Suffragettes

Learning objective: To understand the role of the Suffragettes in campaigning for the right for women to vote.

Follow the steps below to create your poster. Use the word bank to label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a scene showing a Suffragette standing proudly at a peaceful march. Use bright colours for her sash and her banner. Draw the person in a realistic style, showing them holding the banner high above their head to share their message with the world.



Label words: Votes for Women · Sash · Banner · Suffragette · Badge

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a person holding a large banner. Write 'Votes for Women' on the banner.
2. Step 2: Draw a colourful sash across the person's chest.
3. Step 3: Draw a small badge on the person's coat.
4. Step 4: Use an arrow to point to the person and label them 'Suffragette'.
