

Max the Monkey's Angle Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and compare angles as greater than or smaller than a right angle.

Max the Monkey is looking for angles in the jungle. Look at the shapes below. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions. Use the sentence starters to help you write your answers.

Max the Monkey loves finding corners. He knows that a corner that looks like the corner of a square is called a right angle. Some corners are closed up tight and are smaller than a right angle. Other corners are wide open and are larger than a right angle.

Word bank: Right angle · Smaller than · Larger than · Degrees

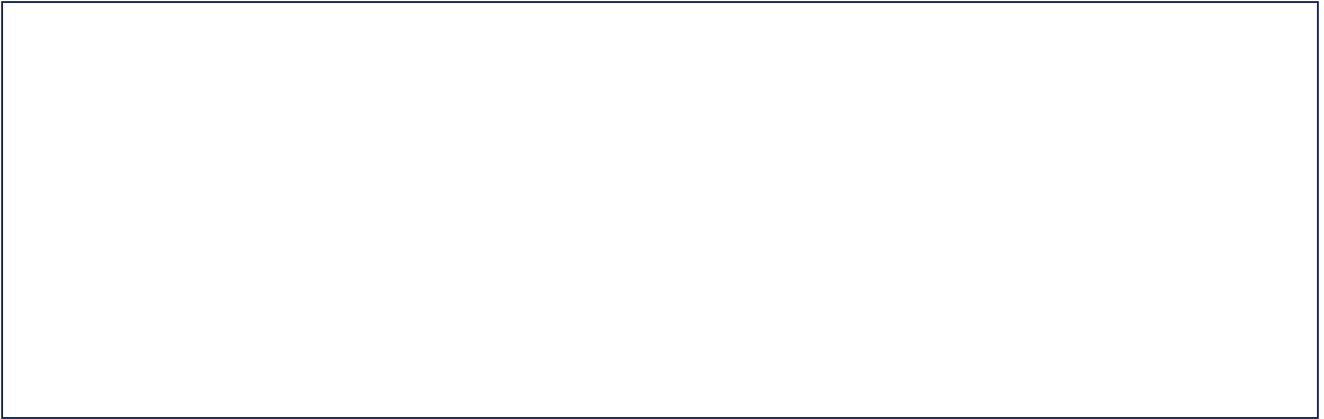
1. Look at a square. What do we call the corners of a square? (1 mark)

2. If an angle is closed up tight and is smaller than a square corner, what do we call it? (1 mark)

3. If an angle is wide open, is it larger or smaller than a right angle? (1 mark)

4. Max found a triangle with a very wide corner. Is this corner larger or smaller than a right angle? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a shape with one right angle and one angle that is smaller than a right angle.



Extension challenge: Can you find three things in your classroom that have right angles? Write them down here.
