

Max the Monkey's Decimal Adventures!

Jump into Decimals with Max: See how parts make a whole!

- A decimal point separates the whole number from the parts of a number.
- When you divide one whole into ten equal parts, each part is one tenth (0.1).
- When you divide one tenth into ten even smaller parts, each part is one hundredth (0.01).
- The digit to the right of the decimal point shows how many tenths you have.
- Max knows that 0.5 is the same as one half of a whole!

Did you know? Did you know? If you have one pound (£1.00) and you split it into 100 equal pieces, each tiny piece is called a penny! A penny is 0.01 of a pound. That is one hundredth!
